**THE ANNUAL MEETING:** The clubs annual membership meeting was held on February 8, 2015. There was good attendance by club members. The ODNR gave an update on hunting and fishing and other information, also answered members questions. Committee reports were given. President, Dennis Meinke, reviewed progress made on improving club facilities and grounds in 2014 as well as plans for future projects for 2015. Our biggest project remains in getting the 5 new Short range bays operational. We need to apply better soil and grading in bays and to put in access drives along front of bays. These 5 new bays were constructed so that pistols shoots could be expanded and maybe additional shoots like Cowboy or multi gun shoots could be held. Also this would keep at least one of the 50 yard bays open to members at all times. We are also in process of putting in new electrical service to rifle ranges and putting 5-stand wiring underground. We are putting metal roofs on many of the clubs buildings. We had good turnouts for work detail days and that always contributes to improving our club grounds and facilities. Thanks to all who have helped with maintenance, events and activities. The Board of Trustees has decided that the activities at last years Jamboree Weekend will be continued this year. Those attending the annual meeting were very happy to hear that especially after seeing last years Fireworks show.

**Club Gate Access**: There are several issues with the gates. Both the main gate on State Route 534 and the gate at the entrance to the new Property on Callahan Road share the same combination and will be changed on or about April 1, 2015. Check your 2015 membership card for the new combination.
