- Course of fire:** CMP Garand B (reduced), 100 yards; 50 rnds, three positions
- Governing rules:** CMP Competition Rules
- Awards:** Top 3, each class
- General information:** **Hearing and eye protection is mandatory.**
Bring your own ammo (60 rnds, minimum).
Bring lunch, water, etc. Food is available in Hartsgrove, two miles south.
Shooting mat or 2' by 6' piece of carpeting is recommended.
Clinic conducted by CMP Master Instructor.
Loaner rifles available, preregistration strongly advised.

- Governing rules:** Civilian Marksmanship Program Competition Rules
- Awards:** Top 3 each class. All juniors.
- General information:** **Hearing and eye protection is mandatory.**
Bring your own ammo (65 rnds, minimum).
Bring water, lunch, etc. Food is available in Hartsgrove, two miles south.
Shooting mat or 2' by 6' piece of carpeting is recommended.
