Location and Directions to Range:	4323 State Route 534, Hartsgrove, Ohio On the west side of Rt. 534, 2 miles north of Hartsgrove (US Rt. 6) <u>or</u> 10 miles south of I-90 (Geneva/Rt. 534 exit)
Open to:	US citizens eligible per CMP rules. Shooters under 18 <u>must</u> be accompanied by parent or legal guardian.
Entry fee:	\$10 Second match \$5
Registration:	8:30 a.m., 10:00 a.m., 11:30 a.m. First shot 30 minutes after registration. Be on time.
Course of Fire:	<u>CMP John C. Garand (reduced)</u> – 30 rounds, 100 yards Service rifle and other shooters may elect to fire <u>Garand B (reduced)</u> – 50 rounds, 100 yards. Service rifles will shoot reduced targets simulating 200, 300, and 600 yds. Stages are fired in reverse order from SR CoF. <u>M1 Carbine</u> – 40 rounds, 100 yards
Governing Rules:	Civilian Marksmanship Program Competition Rules
Awards:	CMP Achievement Pins for each class (except Service Rifle)
General Information:	Hearing and eye protection is mandatory. Bring your own ammo. Bring water, lunch, etc. Excellent sandwiches are available from the Trumbull Locker, about a mile north. Shooting mat or 2' by 6' piece of carpeting is recommended.
