Pig Roast has been CANCELLED

The volunteer that has run the Pig Roast in the past is not available this year. Since we have been unable to find a replacement, we are forced to cancel this years event. If you would like to run the Pig Roast next year, please see any trustee.

Tree Cutting: There will be selective tree cutting behind the 300 yard range this fall. Please observe any range closed signs.

Turkey Shoot: The Annual Sight-In Day and Slug Shoot will be on Sunday, November 10.

Range Safety: There have been several reports of members hearing bullets passing through the trees beyond the ranges. Also, there is evidence (ruts from bullet impacts) of members placing targets on or near the ground. When the bullets strike the ground they are skipping off the ground and going over the berm.

YOU are responsible for every round that you fire!

Make sure that your bullets pass through your target and safely impact the berm. Please use the target stands provided and do not use the target stands as targets.

CLAY TARGET SHOOTING SPORTS: Trap, Skeet and 5-Stand ranges are available to members and non-members at nominal shooting fees. Members: \$3.00 and Non-members: \$4.00. We still need volunteers for the main desk and the 5 Stand throughout the year. Please consider volunteering one Sunday to help keep the Clay target Sports at their peak. Sign up sheets are in the clubhouse. Counts toward your work hours!!!!!!
To support additional persons wishing to shoot trap. Crooked Creek still plans on adding a second trap machine next to the current trap field when demand increases.

Also this summer, as part of Crooked Creek's continued commitment to the youth segment, we will host a Youth Day on September 21st. Member's children, ages 10 to 18, as well as non-members may shoot from 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM. Trap and Skeet will be open for the youth to learn the basics and improve their shooting abilities. Club range officers will be on-site to assist the youth. Parents must stay and watch, but please, do not provide assistance or advice to the youth during their scheduled time on the range. The cost per round (25 targets) will be \$2.00. Please bring your own shotgun and ammo. Parents are welcome to shoot after the youth have had their time on the range. Price per round for parents will be \$ 3.00 for members as well as non-members.

Small Bore Silhouette Matches (1 pm - 5 pm): 10/6.

All future CMP Rimfire Sporter matches will be fired at the regulation distances of 25 and 50 yards.

Range Safety. Do NOT shoot into the ground. Bullets skip off the ground and fly over the berm. This is a serious range safety violation. Your target must be high enough so that your bullets impact the berm, not the ground. You are responsible for every round that you fire. If you witness anyone shooting into the ground, counsel them about range safety. Flagrant violators should be reported to the Trustees. Please use the provided target stands or bring your own, DO NOT use the stands as targets.
